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Abstract: Provides for a rebuttable presumption of compensability in workers' compensation cases.

<u>Present law</u> provides that neither the furnishing of medical services nor payments by the employer or his insurance carrier shall constitute an admission of liability for compensation.

Proposed law retains present law.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that despite the provision of <u>present law</u> (R.S. 23:1031(A)), a rebuttable presumption of compensability shall attach 90 days following the date of an accident.
