INSURANCE: Repeals the effectiveness provision of the insurance fraud investigation unit within the Department of Public Safety and Corrections

1 AN ACT 2 To repeal R.S. 40:1429, relative to the insurance fraud investigation unit within the 3 Department of Public Safety and Corrections; to repeal the effectiveness provision 4 of the insurance fraud investigation unit; and to provide for an effective date. 5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 6 Section 1. R.S. 40:1429 is hereby repealed in its entirety. 7 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not 8 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature 9 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If 10 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become 11 effective on the day following such approval.

Abstract: Repeals the termination date of the insurance fraud investigation unit within the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections.

<u>Present law</u> provides for the insurance fraud investigation unit within the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections. Generally requires the insurance fraud investigation unit to conduct independent inquiries and investigations into allegations of insurance fraud.

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CODING: Words in struck through type are deletions from existing law; words <u>underscored</u> are additions.

Present law terminates the insurance fraud investigation unit on July 1, 2024.

<u>Proposed law</u> repeals the unit's effectiveness provision and termination date. Otherwise retains <u>present law</u>.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.

(Repeals R.S. 40:1429)
