2 On page 4, delete line 27 and line 28, and insert the following:

3	"D. (1) Any violation of this Section shall constitute a moving violation.
4	(1) If a violation of this Section occurs in a school zone or in a highway
5	work zone it shall be a primary offense and shall be punishable as follows:
6	(a) The first violation of the provisions of this Section shall be punishable
7	by a fine of not more than five hundred dollars.
8	(b) Each subsequent violation shall be punishable by a fine of not more
9	than one thousand dollars and a suspension of driver's license for a sixty-day
10	period.
11	(c) If a person is involved in a crash at the time of the violation, then the
12	fine shall be equal to double the amount of the fine imposed in this Subsection
13	and the law enforcement officer investigating the crash shall indicate on the
14	written accident report that the person was using a wireless telecommunications
15	device at the time of the crash.
16	(2) If a violation of this Section occurs in any location other than a school
17	zone or highway work zone it shall be a"
