Abstract: Adds postsecondary education credentials as academic qualifications for individual title insurance producers.

<u>Present law</u> provides certain academic qualifications for licensed title insurance producers. Requires a title insurance producer to have a high school diploma, a diploma for completion of an approved home study program, or a high school equivalency diploma.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and adds a certificate, diploma, or degree from an accredited institution of postsecondary education as an academic qualifier for individual title insurance producers.
