5	Section 2. This Act shall become effective on July 4, 2024; if vetoed by the governor
6	and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day
7	following such approval by the legislature or July 4, 2024, whichever is later.

Talbot

<u>Present law</u> provides relative to the crime of illegal carrying of weapons. Effective July 4, 2024, Section 1 of Act 1 of the 2024 Second Extraordinary Session makes it lawful for any person 18 years of age or older who is not prohibited from possessing a firearm under state or federal law to carry a concealed weapon without a permit, subject to restrictions contained in <u>present law</u> relative to concealed handgun permits.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that carrying a concealed handgun is prohibited at certain sporting events.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that carrying a concealed handgun without possessing a valid concealed handgun permit is unlawful in the French Quarter Management District.

Effective July 4, 2024.
