FAMILY LAW: Provides relative to forced heirship

1	AN ACT
2	To amend and reenact Civil Code Article 1493(A), (B), and (D), relative to forced heirship;
3	to provide relative to the age of a forced heir; and to provide for related matters.
4	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
5	Section 1. Civil Code Article 1493(A), (B), and (D) are hereby amended and
6	reenacted to read as follows:
7	Art. 1493. Forced heirs; representation of forced heirs
8	A. Forced heirs are descendants of the first degree who, at the time of the
9	death of the decedent, are twenty-three eighteen years of age or younger or
10	descendants of the first degree of any age who, because of mental incapacity or
11	physical infirmity, are permanently incapable of taking care of their persons or
12	administering their estates at the time of the death of the decedent.
13	B. When a descendant of the first degree predeceases the decedent,
14	representation takes place for purposes of forced heirship only if the descendant of
15	the first degree would have been twenty-three eighteen years of age or younger at the
16	time of the decedent's death.

18	D. For purposes of this Article, a person is twenty-three eighteen years of
19	age or younger until he attains the age of twenty-four nineteen years.

Abstract: Lowers the age of a forced heir from 23 of age or younger to 18 years of age or younger.

Present law provides that the age of a forced heir is 23 years of age or younger.

<u>Proposed law</u> changes <u>present law</u> to provide that the age of a forced heir is 18 years of age or younger.
