Abstract: Provides for trauma-informed training for judges.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that beginning Jan. 1, 2025, all supreme court justices, courts of appeal judges, district court judges, parish court judges, and city court judges shall annually attend a specialized trauma-informed eight hour course. Provides that this course shall be implemented and developed by the supreme court.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the supreme court to establish a committee including but not limited to designees from the following:

- (1) The Louisiana Coalition Against Domestic Violence.
- (2) The Tulane School of Law Domestic Violence Clinic.
- (3) Children's Hospital of New Orleans.
- (4) The Louisiana State Bar Association.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the eight hour training course to cover certain topics relative to family violence and child abuse.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the Law Library of Louisiana to maintain a current online and printed database of training materials prepared in compliance with proposed law.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
