**Abstract:** Urges the Public Service Commission to explore excluding from the definition of public utility persons or corporations that furnish electricity to charge marine vessels and power points.

<u>Present law</u> provides that it is the intent of the legislature to promote rapid development of a statewide electric vehicle charging network. <u>Present law</u> additionally urges the Public Service Commission to explore excluding certain persons or corporations from the definition of public utility.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and adds persons or corporations that furnish electricity exclusively to charge marine vessels and vessel-mounted or on-shore power points that are primarily used for marine vessels.
