2	To amend and reenact R.S. 17:240(A)(2), (B)(2), and (C)(2), to provide relative to the use
3	of vapes at school; to provide relative to smoking or vaping marijuana,
4	tetrahydrocannabinol, or chemical derivatives on any school property; to provide for
5	punishment; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 17:240(A)(2), (B)(2), and (C)(2) are hereby amended and reenacted
8	to read as follows:
9	§240. Prohibition against use of tobacco and marijuana in schools; prohibition
10	against smoking on school bus; rules and regulations
11	A. For purposes of this Section the following terms shall have the following
12	meanings unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
13	* * *
14	(2) "Smoking" means possession of a lighted cigar, cigarette, pipe, or any
15	other lighted tobacco or marijuana product, including but not limited to e-cigs, e-
16	cigarettes, electronic cigarettes, advanced personal vaporizers, vape pens, and vape
17	mods.

2	(2)(a) No person shall smoke or carry a lighted cigar, cigarette, pipe, or any
3	other form of smoking object or device, including but not limited to e-cigs, e-
4	cigarettes, electronic cigarettes, advanced personal vaporizers, vape pens, and vape

6	(b) No person shall smoke or vape any form of marijuana as defined by
7	R.S. 40:961, or a substance classified in Schedule I that is marijuana,
8	tetrahydrocannabinol, or chemical derivatives thereof on any school property.

11	(2)(a) The governing authority of each public elementary or secondary school
12	and each nonpublic elementary or secondary school may provide for appropriate
13	penalties for violators, including but not limited to disciplinary action or a fine not
14	to exceed two hundred dollars, or both.
15	(b) Any person who violates Subparagraph (2)(b) of Subsection B of this
16	Section shall be subject to punishment pursuant to R.S. 40:981.3(A)(1).

18	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
19	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
20	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
21	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
22	effective on the day following such approval.

SB 434 Original

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and further provides that smoking or vaping any form of marijuana on any school property is prohibited.
