Jackson-Andrews

<u>Proposed law</u> requires a student remain a resident of Louisiana and be employed in the state for 36 months after the student's graduation from a college or university.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the Louisiana Office of Student Financial Assistance is responsible for recouping not more than 1/3 of the total amount paid out by TOPS award for each year the student does not reside in Louisiana.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the Louisiana Office of Student Financial Assistance, in conjunction with the Board of Regents, will promulgate rules and regulations needed to provide for compliance, enforcement, and penalties.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the Louisiana Office of Student Financial Assistance, in conjunction with the Board of Regents, to provide a mechanism for informing students of the requirements of the proposed law, a notification procedure for students who fail to meet the requirements, and guidelines and procedures for payment options.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the Louisiana Office of Student Financial Assistance to submit a written report to the Senate and House Committees on Education containing information required by <u>proposed law</u> for the preceding academic year.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
