5	Section 1. R.S. 9:410 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
6	§410. Filiation; ordinary proceedings
7	A filiation action pursuant to Civil Code Article 197 shall be a civil
8	action brought in an ordinary proceeding under Book II of the Code of Civil
9	Procedure, and may be instituted separately or cumulated in a succession
10	proceeding. However, the mere commencement of a succession proceeding
11	under Book VI of the Code of Civil Procedure shall not constitute the instituting
12	of a filiation action for purposes of Civil Code Article 197.
13	Section 2. The provisions of this Act shall be interpretive, procedural, and remedial.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that a filiation action pursuant to <u>present law</u> shall be a civil action brought in an ordinary proceeding under Book II of the C.C.P., and may be instituted separately or cumulated in a succession proceeding. <u>Proposed law</u> further provides that the mere commencement of a succession proceeding under Book VI of the C.C.P. shall not constitute the instituting of a filiation action for purposes of <u>present law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the provisions of <u>proposed law</u> shall be interpretive, procedural, and remedial.
