Boudreaux

<u>Present law</u> provides that certain employees of the Lafayette Consolidated Government, employees of a department created by the Lafayette home rule charter, who were first employed on or after Nov. 1, 2010, become a member of MERS. Applicable to the same departments of Lafayette government, those hired on or after Nov. 1, 2020, become members of PERS instead of MERS. <u>Proposed law</u> retains present law but provides for technical updates.

Present law provides for a maximum amortization payment period of 10 years.

<u>Proposed law retains present law</u> but provides the exception for Lafayette Consolidated Government to elect to reamortize over a period not to exceed 20 years instead and further provides that should Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government make such an election, the amortization period shall be retroactive to Nov. 1, 2020.

Effective August 1, 2024.
