26	E.(1) A health insurance issuer may require that all covered
27	services pursuant to this Section receive prior authorization from the
28	<u>issuer.</u>
29	(2) Nothing in this Section shall be interpreted to require a health
30	insurance issuer to provide coverage for injectable drugs used to lower
31	glucose levels or any other drugs prescribed for weight loss. A health
32	insurance issuer may limit benefits provided in this Section to no more
33	<u>than one surgical procedure per lifetime."</u>

3	"(1) "Body mass index" means a practical marker used to assess
4	the degree of obesity, calculated by dividing the weight in kilograms by
5	the height in meters squared.
6	(2) "Health coverage plan" means any hospital, health, or
7	medical expense insurance policy, hospital or medical service contract,
8	employee welfare benefit plan, contract, or other agreement with a
9	health maintenance organization or a preferred provider organization,
10	health and accident insurance policy, or any other insurance contract of
11	this type in this state, including a group insurance plan, and a
12	self-insurance plan. "Health coverage plan" does not include a plan
13	providing coverage for excepted benefits defined in R.S. 22:1061, limited
14	benefit health insurance plans, and short-term policies that have a term
15	of less than twelve months or the Office of Group Benefits programs."

"Section 2. This Act shall apply to any new policy, contract, program,
or health coverage plan issued on and after January 1, 2025. Any policy,
contract, or health coverage plan in effect prior to January 1, 2025, shall
convert to conform this Act on or before the renewal date, but no later than
January 1, 2026."
