**Abstract:** Prohibits the use of "construction management at risk" for projects that cost less than two million dollars for hospital service districts.

<u>Present law</u> prohibits "construction management at risk" (CMAR) from being used for any project that is estimated to cost less than \$5,000,000.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds an exception for hospital service districts as defined by <u>present law</u>, which may not use CMAR for projects that cost less than \$2,000,000.

<u>Proposed law</u> removes the requirement in <u>present law</u> for House and Senate transportation, highways and public works committee review and approval for CMAR projects costing between \$5,000,000 and \$15,000,000.

## Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Transportation</u>, <u>Highways and Public Works to the original bill:</u>

1. Remove the requirement in <u>present law</u> for House and Senate transportation, highways and public works committee review and approval for CMAR projects costing between \$5,000,000 and \$15,000,000.
