 "and other issues related to certain children's attainment of the age of majority;"

5 On page 1, line 13, after "regarding" delete the remainder of the line and delete lines 14 6 through 19 and on page 2, delete lines 1 through 4 and insert the following:

7	"legal procedures affecting the transfer of individual rights from parent to
8	child when the child attains the age of majority, including but not limited to
9	supported decision making, power of attorney, continuing or permanent
10	tutorship, and limited and full interdiction, to parents as provided in this
11	Subsection.
12	(2) The document shall inform parents of legal options and how each
13	option relates to such transfer of rights.
14	(3) At the child's first Individualized Education Program meeting of
15	the school year, the document shall be provided to a parent of each child who
16	is fourteen, fifteen, sixteen, or seventeen years old who participates in
17	alternate assessment pursuant to R.S. 17:24.4(F)(3) or an alternate pathway
18	to promotion pursuant to R.S. 17:24.4(H). Parents shall be provided a form
19	by which to confirm receipt of the information."

- 21 On page 2, between lines 8 and 9, insert the following:
- "(6) The information provided as required by this Subsection is not
 intended to be legal advice, which the document provided shall indicate, and
 the local education agency shall have no liability for claims arising from the
 information provided."
