Abstract: Allows supervision for certain social workers and licensed professional counselors to be conducted in-person or remotely via telesupervision.

<u>Present law</u> defines "qualified supervision", along with other terms relative to licensed professional counselors. <u>Proposed law</u> adds a definition for "telesupervision" and otherwise retains <u>present law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the requirements for supervision set forth in <u>present law</u> for licensed professional counselors may be satisfied via telesupervision. <u>Proposed law</u> otherwise retains <u>present</u> law.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the Louisiana Licensed Professional Counselors Board of Examiners to establish rules and regulations regarding parameters and requirements for telesupervision.

<u>Present law</u> defines "clinical supervision" and "supervision", along with other terms relative to social work.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds definitions for "in-person supervision" and "telesupervision" to provisions relative to social work. Proposed law otherwise retains present law.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> provisions and further provides that supervision between a licensed clinical social worker and a licensed master's social worker may be conducted in-person or remotely via telesupervision.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires telesupervision to adhere to the same standards and guidelines as in-person supervision, to ensure regular contact, case review, and ongoing professional development.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the La. State Bd. of Social Work Examiners to establish rules and regulations regarding the requirements and parameters for telesupervision.

<u>Present law</u> allows a social worker licensed at the licensed master's social worker level to practice clinical social work and psychotherapy within an agency under the supervision of a licensed clinical social worker.

<u>Proposed law</u> further provides that the supervision required in <u>present law</u> may be conducted in-person or virtually.

Proposed law otherwise retains present law.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Health and Welfare</u> to the original bill:

- 1. Add a definition for "telesupervision" to <u>present law</u> provisions relative to licensed professional counselors.
- 2. Provide that the requirements for supervision set forth in <u>present law</u> for licensed professional counselors may be satisfied via telesupervision.
- 3. Require the La. Licensed Professional Counselors Bd. of Examiners to establish rules and regulations regarding parameters and requirements for telesupervision.
- 4. Make technical corrections.
