3	WHEREAS, travel plays an essential role in preserving Louisiana's culture, propels
4	our economy, and is pivotal in shaping Louisiana's success; and
5	WHEREAS, travel is vital in creating quality job opportunities with over 218,900
6	people employed in the leisure and hospitality industry regaining its status as the industry
7	with the fourth highest employment in the state; and
8	WHEREAS, Louisiana attracted 42.6 million domestic and international visitors to
9	the state in 2022, a 3.8% increase over 2021; and
10	WHEREAS, domestic and international travelers spent an estimated \$17.1 billion
11	while visiting Louisiana in 2022, a 2.3% increase over 2021; and
12	WHEREAS, no state general funds are appropriated for tourism; tourism is funded
13	exclusively by a dedication of three one-hundredths of a cent of sales tax; and
14	WHEREAS, the funds generated by this dedication have been and continue to be
15	used by the Louisiana Office of Tourism under the direction of our Lt. Governor Billy
16	Nungesser, to promote tourism to our state, which has created an enormous economic
17	impact; and
18	WHEREAS, members of the travel community that represent all corners of Louisiana
