Abstract: Provides relative to the penalties for the crime of possession of a firearm or carrying of a concealed weapon by a felon.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 14:95.1) provides for the crime of possession of a firearm or carrying a concealed weapon by a person convicted of certain felonies and provides for penalties.

Proposed law retains present law.

<u>Proposed</u> law provides that if the offender is found guilty of violating the provisions of <u>present law</u> while on probation or parole, the sentence imposed pursuant to <u>present law</u> shall be served consecutively with the remaining balance of any sentence to be served for a prior conviction for any offense in accordance with <u>present law</u> (C.Cr.P. Art. 901).
