

Proposed law repeals the lung cancer reporting requirement of the board.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.

(Amends R.S. 40:1103.3(A), 1103.5(4), 1105.1(1), 1105.3(4), 1105.5, 1105.8.1(D)(1)(b)(iii) and (G), and 1105.9(A)(1), (B), (C)(1), (D), (E), and (F), 1105.12(F)(4), and 1105.13(C) and R.S. 47:120.63; adds R.S. 40:1105.1(8); repeals R.S. 40:1105.11)

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Health and Welfare to the original bill

1. Adds a member to the advisory board.

Senate Floor Amendments to engrossed bill

1. Adds provision for the La. Tumor Registry to enter into agreements allowing remote electronic access to records of cancer patients.
2. Adds a representative of the Franciscan Missionaries of Our Lady Health System and a representative from Woman's Hospital to the board.
