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Constitutional amendment to authorize the legislature, by law, to establish additional courts enacted by a two-thirds vote.

(2/3 - CA12s1(A))

Present constitution provides that the judicial power is vested in a supreme court, courts of appeal, district courts, and other courts authorized in the constitution. Proposed constitutional amendment allows the legislature, by a 2/3rds vote of each house, to create additional courts. Specifies submission of the amendment to the voters at the statewide election to be held on November 5, 2024.
