14	after the victory, he served as Representative Scott's legislative assistant until 1984; and
15	WHEREAS, Dennie accepted a position as an investors relations specialist at
16	CLECO in 1984; he was promoted to director of risk management and insurance claims, and
17	he worked in that role until 1996; he semi-retired as a senior governmental service
18	representative for CLECO in 2017, but he continued to serve the company as a consultant
19	for another three years before fully retiring in 2020; and
