1 A RESOLUTION 2 To commend the LSU Health Foundation New Orleans and Dr. Steve Nelson, Interim Chancellor of the LSU Health Sciences Center New Orleans, upon receipt of a \$7.5 3 million gift to fund ten four-year scholarships to the medical school. 4 5 WHEREAS, Dr. Steve Nelson's leadership in academic medicine, notably as Dean of the Medical School and Interim Chancellor at LSU Health Sciences Center, has been 6 7 characterized by a tireless pursuit of excellence and innovation; and 8 WHEREAS, a graduate of State University of New York at Stony Brook, Dr. Steve 9 Nelson earned a medical degree as a University Scholar at McGill University, and completed 10 a residency in internal medicine at Johns Hopkins University along with a Clinical 11 Fellowship in Pulmonary/Critical Care Medicine, a Research Fellowship in Pulmonary Medicine, as well as a Fellowship in Environmental Health Sciences at the Johns Hopkins 12 13 University School of Hygiene and Public; and 14 WHEREAS, Dr. Steve Nelson's illustrious career has spanned decades of unwavering dedication to the advancement of medical science, healthcare education, and compassionate 15 patient care; he joined the faculty of the LSU Health Sciences Center in New Orleans in 16 1984, became the John H. Seabury Professor of Medicine in 1985, and further held joint 17 appointments in the Departments of Physiology, Microbiology, Immunology, and 18

Parasitology, and in the School of Graduate Studies; and

WHEREAS, confidence in Dr. Nelson's leadership, dedication, and experience in the advancement of medical science and healthcare education is evidenced through the generosity of the Estate of Marcia and Billy Beer in the recent gift of \$7.5 million to the LSU Health New Orleans Foundation; and

WHEREAS, this generous endowment, the largest in the Foundation's history, sets a new standard for philanthropy in support of medical education and will have a profound and lasting impact on the lives of countless aspiring physicians and the communities they serve; and

WHEREAS, the decision to allocate these funds for four-year tuition scholarships at the LSU Health New Orleans School of Medicine reflects a deep commitment to fostering the next generation of healthcare professionals; and

WHEREAS, by funding additional scholarships through the interest earned on this gift while preserving the principal, the Beer family has ensured that their legacy will continue to benefit future generations of students indefinitely; and

WHEREAS, the unique request from the Beers family, asking scholarship recipients to give back by providing one day of free medical care each month upon completing their medical training, demonstrates a profound understanding of the importance of compassionate healthcare and community service; a stipulation that not only honors the spirit of generosity embodied by the Beer family but reinforces the values of altruism and empathy within the medical profession; and
