<u>Present law</u> provides no person shall be permitted to register or vote who is either under an order or imprisonment for conviction of a felony unless they have not been incarcerated pursuant to the order within the last five years or interdicted after being judicially declared to be mentally incompetent.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and further provides that American citizenship is required to register to vote.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the voter registration application form must contain space for the applicant to provide his name, date of birth, place of residence, Louisiana driver's license number or special identification card number, if he has one, and the date of application.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and further requires space for an applicant to provide proof of American citizenship.
