A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To posthumously commend Joseph U. "Mr. Joe" Pierre, Sr., for his contributions to
Ascension Parish.

WHEREAS, Councilman Joseph U. Pierre, Sr., known in the political sector as
"Mr. Joe", was a distinguished man of faith, wisdom, and integrity; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Joe honorably served his country as a United States Army soldier
during the Korean War, demonstrating his patriotism and valor; and

WHEREAS, following his distinguished military service, Mr. Joe transitioned into
