16"D. There is hereby authorized the formation and incorporation17of a nonprofit corporation authorized to assist the department with state18economic development in addition to the powers granted by the19nonprofit corporation law, as provided in Chapter 2 of Title 12 of the20Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950.

(1) The nonprofit corporation shall be a private entity that shall not be deemed to be a public or quasi-public corporation or an administrative unit, public servant, employee, or agent of the state, a state agency, board, commission, or political subdivision for any purpose whatsoever, if it meets all the following criteria:

(a) The voting members of the nonprofit corporation's board of directors are not public employees or an elected official.

(b) The nonprofit corporation is under the management and control of a board of directors.

(c) The nonprofit corporation reimburses, either directly or through in-kind services, the cost of leasing public personnel, which personnel shall remain public servants for all purposes.

(2) The receipt, investment, or expenditure of public funds shall 33 34 not affect the private status of any nonprofit corporation meeting the 35 criteria set forth in Paragraph (1) of this Subsection, however, books and 36 records of any such corporation, to the extent that such books and 37 records directly pertain to the receipt, investment, or expenditure of public funds, shall be subject to R.S. 44:1 et seq. No other books and 38 39 records of any such nonprofit corporation shall be subject to R.S. 44:1 40 et seq.
