2 To enact R.S. 17:184 and 3996(B)(82) and to repeal R.S. 17:7(31), relative to grades 3 assigned in public schools; to require all public schools to use a uniform ten-point 4 grading scale; to repeal the requirement that the State Board of Elementary and 5 Secondary Education provide for the implementation of a uniform grading scale; and 6 to provide for related matters. 7 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 8 Section 1. R.S. 17:184 and 3996(B)(82) are hereby enacted to read as follows: 9 §184. Uniform grading scale 10 A. Each public school governing authority shall use the following ten-point 11 grading scale for students enrolled in any grade for which letter grades are used: 12 (1) One hundred points through ninety points is an A. 13 (2) Eighty-nine points through eighty points is a B. 14 (3) Seventy-nine points through seventy points is a C. 15 (4) Sixty-nine points through sixty points is a D. 16 (5) Fifty-nine points through zero points in an F. 17 B. The provisions of Subsection A of this Section do not apply to any school that is operated by the United States Department of Defense and that is located on 18 19 a federal military installation. 20

Abstract: Requires all public schools to use a uniform 10-point grading scale.

Section 2. R.S. 17:7(31) is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Present law requires the State Bd. of Elementary and Secondary Education (BESE) to provide for the implementation of a uniform grading scale for use in all public school except for certain schools operated by the U.S. Dept. of Defense; BESE provides this in present administrative rule (BESE policy), which requires a seven-point grading scale (100-93: A, 92-85: B, 84-75: C; 74-67: D; 66-0: F).

Proposed law repeals present law and requires all public schools, including charter schools, to use a uniform 10-point grading scale (100-90: A; 89-80: B; 79-70: C; 69-60: D; 59-0: F). Provides same exception for Dept. of Defense schools.
