SB 215 Engrossed 2024 Regular Session Fesi

<u>Present law</u> provides for the duties of the office of multimodal commerce within the Department of Transportation and Development (DOTD).

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and specifies that vertiports are included in aviation relative to DOTD and multimodal commerce.

Proposed law creates the Louisiana Vertiport Development Fund.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires DOTD to develop regulations and guidelines for the distribution and allocation of any monies in the fund.

Effective August 1, 2024.

(Amends R.S. 36:508.3(A)(1); adds R.S. 48:80)

- 1. Remove <u>proposed law</u> provisions creating the Louisiana Vertiport Development Fund in Title 36 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950.
- 2. Add provisions creating the Louisiana Vertiport Development Fund in Title 48 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950.
- 3. Remove the requirement that interest earned on the investment of monies in the fund be credited to the Bond Security and Redemption Fund.
- 4. Require all monies appropriated or transferred to the fund to be credited to the Bond Security and Redemption Fund.
