<u>Present law</u> provides certain reimbursement requirements and prohibitions for pharmacy benefit managers or persons acting on behalf of a pharmacy benefit manager.

<u>Proposed law</u> prohibits pharmacy benefit managers or persons acting on behalf of pharmacy benefit managers from reimbursing a pharmacy or pharmacist in this state an amount less than the acquisition cost for any covered drug, device, or service. <u>Proposed law</u> applies to only a contracted pharmacist or pharmacy that does not own more than five shares or a five percent interest in a pharmaceutical wholesale group purchasing organization or vendor of any covered drug, device, or service.

<u>Present law</u> establishes an administrative appeal procedure for pharmacies to challenge reimbursement received from a pharmacy benefit manager and requires the pharmacy benefit manager to make certain information available to the commissioner of insurance upon request.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires the pharmacy benefit manager to provide the information to the commissioner without a request from the commissioner.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
