## DIGEST OF THE SENATE BILL AS RETURNED TO THE SENATE

<u>Present law</u> provides that "infant" means a child not previously subjected to abuse or neglect, who is not more than 60 days old as determined within a reasonable degree of medical certainty by an examining physician.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and further provides, if the infant was admitted to a neonatal intensive care unit upon birth and has not been discharged from the hospital, then the 60 days shall commence from the date of initial discharge.

Effective August 1, 2024.
