1 A RESOLUTION

2 To recognize May 29, 2024, as New Orleans Day at the state capitol.

3 WHEREAS, Louisiana is nationally and internationally recognized as the most
4 unique state in the nation, and the city of New Orleans plays a vital role in the distinction
5 that the state enjoys in this regard; and

6 WHEREAS, the culture of Louisiana is woven throughout the very fabric of the city
7 of New Orleans, which includes residents from throughout the state who now call the city
8 home; and

9 WHEREAS, the House of Representatives recognizes the many economic, cultural,
10 and artistic contributions of the city of New Orleans; and

11 WHEREAS, the House of Representatives also recognizes the global prominence of
12 the city of New Orleans, which is a world-class city that features events of national
13 importance, cutting-edge technology, and innovation with respect to green and blue
14 infrastructure; and

15 WHEREAS, the city of New Orleans is a quilt that is embroidered of new and old
16 neighborhoods of distinction; it is the cultural diversity of the people of the city that makes
17 New Orleans the remarkable place it is today.

18 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
19 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby recognize May 29, 2024, as New Orleans Day at the
20 state capitol and does hereby call upon the citizens of Louisiana to observe this day by
21 celebrating the unique culture and history of the Crescent City.
