2	To request the Coastal Protection and Restoration Authority to perform a cost benefit
3	analysis on merging the Lafitte Area Independent Levee District with the Southeast
4	Louisiana Flood Protection Authority-West.
5	WHEREAS, the Southeast Louisiana Flood Protection Authority-West
6	(SLFPA-West) is one of two levee authorities serving metropolitan New Orleans; and
7	WHEREAS, SLFPA-West provides flood protection for the most populated areas on
8	the west bank of the Mississippi River in Jefferson and Orleans parishes by building,
9	operating, and maintaining flood control systems; and
10	WHEREAS, the jurisdiction of the SLFPA-West covers approximately forty-seven
11	miles of hurricane flood protection levees, floodwalls, and floodgates and approximately
12	thirty-three miles of Mississippi River levees and floodwalls; and
13	WHEREAS, a seven-member board of commissioners oversees SLFPA-West, which
14	is made up of two levee districts, the West Jefferson Levee District, serving the west bank
15	portions of Jefferson Parish, and the Algiers Levee District, serving the west bank portions
16	of Orleans Parish; and
17	WHEREAS, the Algiers Levee District was reorganized to encompass the portion
18	of the parish of Orleans on the west side of the Mississippi River, and the West Jefferson

Levee District was reorganized to encompass all lands in the parish of Jefferson on the west side of the Mississippi River, except that area of land contained in the Lafitte Area Independent Levee District.
