4 WHEREAS, on Wednesday, April 24, 2024, Loren Lampert was officially sworn in
5 as a judge in the 9th Judicial District Court for Division "D" at the Rapides Parish
6 Courthouse; and

7 WHEREAS, Judge Lampert won the judgeship by defeating attorney Allie Nowlin
8 in the March 2024 election, demonstrating the trust and confidence placed in him by the
9 community; and

10 WHEREAS, Judge Lampert brings a wealth of experience to the bench, having
11 previously served as chief of police for the Alexandria Police Department, as a district
12 attorney, and numerous other significant roles in his distinguished law enforcement career;

14 WHEREAS, numerous local and state officials attended the swearing-in ceremony
15 and spoke on Judge Lampert's numerous accomplishments and his dedication to the
16 principles of justice; and

17 WHEREAS, after being sworn in, Judge Lampert articulated his goals and vision for
18 his tenure as a judge, emphasizing the importance of fairness, competence, and thoroughness

1 in all judicial proceedings before Division "D."
