Existing law (R.S. 15:574.4) provides for parole eligibility for certain offenders who meet certain requirements.

New law retains existing law.

New law (R.S. 15:574.22) provides that no person committed to the DPS&C for an offense committed on or after Aug. 1, 2024, shall be eligible for parole except a person who satisfies the provisions of existing law (R.S. 15:574.4(D), (E), (F), (G), (H), or (K)).

Effective April 29, 2024.
