Existing law provides that no revocation, suspension, annulment, or withdrawal of any license is lawful unless, prior to the institution of agency proceedings, the agency gives notice by mail to the licensee of facts or conduct which warrant the intended action and the licensee is given an opportunity to show compliance with all lawful requirements for the retention of the license.

New law authorizes the agency to provide the required notice through electronic means as prescribed by the agency.

Effective August 1, 2024.
