ACT 140 (HB 814)

Prior law prohibited barber colleges from admitting students under 17 years of age.

New law changes the age limit for barber college admission from 17 to 16 years of age unless the student is enrolled in a board-approved barber college that operates within a state high school.

Existing law requires the board to examine and determine if an applicant, other than a barber who is covered by reciprocity pursuant to existing law, qualifies for a certificate of registration to practice barbering in the state.

Prior law required the applicant to be at least 18 years old to qualify for a certificate of registration to practice barbering in the state.

New law changes the age requirement for certification from 18 years old to 17 years old.

Effective August 1, 2024.
