Abraham

<u>Present law</u> provides for facilities providing housing or temporary residence to individuals referred by judicial agencies.

<u>Present law</u> prohibits any facility providing housing or temporary residence to any individual and prohibits any judicial agency from referring any individual to a facility providing housing or temporary residence until the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections (DPS&C) has adopted rules and has inspected the facility and certified that the facility is in compliance with these rules as provided for by <u>present law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u>, but also requires that DPS&C adopt rules and inspect the facility and certify that the facility is in compliance regarding "treatment" facilities.

<u>Present law</u> defines "judicial agency" as the district court and officers thereof, including the district judge, the prosecutor and district attorneys. <u>Present law</u> prohibits any sheriff or sheriff's department from being deemed a judicial agency as provided by <u>present law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u>, and adds sheriffs and sheriff departments to the definition of "judicial agency".
