**Abstract:** Requires a hospital to grant emergency privileges that allow a healthcare professional to perform a unique procedure on a patient in hospital where he is not generally authorized to practice medicine.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires a hospital transferring a patient to another hospital to grant emergency privileges that allow a qualified healthcare professional to administer a unique procedure to a patient admitted to the transferring hospital.

<u>Proposed law</u> states that a healthcare professional shall qualify for emergency privileges if he is performing a unique procedure intended to stabilize a patient, and he is credentialed to provide the same procedure in the hospital receiving the patient.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that emergency privileges are valid for the duration of the unique procedure.

<u>Proposed law</u> states that the healthcare professional shall provide notice to the transferring hospital that he intends to perform a unique procedure at the visiting hospital, and the hospital has one hour from receiving the notice to grant emergency privileges.

Proposed law defines terms.
