<u>Present law</u> authorizes an individual income tax exemption on 50% of the gross wages of each taxpayer who qualifies as a digital nomad not to exceed \$150,000.

Proposed law retains present law.

Present law authorizes the exemption to apply to taxable years 2022, 2023, 2024, and 2025.

Proposed law expands the years to which the exemption may apply to include 2026 and 2027.

Present law prohibits the exemption for wages of digital nomads earned after December 31, 2025.

<u>Proposed law</u> extends the sunset of the exemption <u>from</u> wages earned after December 31, 2025, <u>to</u> wages earned after December 31, 2027.

Effective August 1, 2025.
