7	appointment shall be made from by the governor, who may consider a list of three
8	or more names submitted to the governor by the Society of Louisiana Certified
9	Public Accountants or its successor.

18	minority and a member of the nominating organization.

20	person may not appear on more than one list.

2	have the qualifications required by R.S. 37:684.

14	C. Each member of the board shall be appointed by the governor as follows:
15	(1)(a) One dentist shall be appointed from each board district, except that
16	two dentists shall be appointed from District Five and designated as representatives
17	"A" and "B". Each appointment from an electoral district shall may be made from
18	a list of three names of nominees for the respective district submitted to the governor
19	by the board. The district nominees shall be selected from the roster of licensed
20	dentists in the districts at a nominating meeting convened in accordance with the
21	provisions of Subsection F of this Section. The voting domicile of each nominee for
22	appointment and not his office address shall determine his district for purposes of
23	holding office in accordance with the provisions of this Paragraph. The nominating
24	meeting shall be held at least ninety days prior to the vacancy occurring by reason
25	of an expiring term or within thirty days after a vacancy occurring by reason of
26	death, resignation, or for any other reason.

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(2) Three dentists shall be appointed from the state at large to fill seats designated as "At-Large Seats A, B, and C" in accordance with the following requirements:

4 (a) One seat shall be designated as "At-Large Seat A" and shall be appointed from the state at large and may be appointed from a list of three licensed black 5 6 dentists certified by the board secretary to the governor. The board secretary shall obtain a list of three nominees for the "At-Large Seat A" position by ballot sent by 7 8 United States mail to all licensed black dentists in the state at their last known 9 mailing address as indicated in the board files. Each licensed black dentist may 10 nominate any three licensed black dentists by completing the ballot with the full 11 name, residence, address, city, and home telephone number of the three nominees 12 and mailing the ballot to the board offices. The submission of such information on 13 the ballot shall serve as confirmation that the voter has discussed the nomination 14 with the nominees and they have agreed to serve if nominated and appointed by the 15 governor. The ballot shall be mailed by the board secretary at least ninety days prior 16 to any vacancy occurring by reason of an expiring term or within thirty days after a 17 vacancy occurring by reason of death, resignation, or for any other reason. After the 18 board secretary has tabulated all ballots received at the board offices, the names of 19 the three nominees receiving the greatest number of votes shall be certified by the 20 secretary and sent to the governor.

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22 (3) The hygienist shall be appointed from the state at large, and may be 23 appointed from a list of three nominees certified by the board secretary and sent to 24 the governor. The board secretary shall obtain a list of three nominees for the 25 at-large dental hygienist position by ballot sent by United States mail to all licensed 26 dental hygienists in the state at their last known mailing address as indicated in the 27 board files. Each licensed dental hygienist may nominate any three licensed dental 28 hygienists by completing the ballot with the full name, residence, address, city, and 29 home telephone number of the three nominees, and mailing same to the board

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1	offices. The submission of such information on the ballot shall serve as confirmation
2	that the voter has discussed the nomination with the nominees and they have agreed
3	to serve if nominated and appointed by the governor. The ballot shall be mailed out
4	by the board secretary at least ninety days prior to any vacancy occurring by reason
5	of an expiring term or within thirty days after a vacancy occurring by reason of
6	death, resignation, or for any other reason. After the board secretary has tabulated
7	all ballots received at the board offices, the names of the three nominees receiving
8	the largest number of votes shall be certified by the secretary and sent to the
9	governor.

14	B.(1) The board shall be composed of eight registered nurses appointed by
15	the governor from who may consider a list of names submitted by the Louisiana
16	State Nurses Association, one certified registered nurse anesthetist appointed by the
17	governor from who may consider a list of names submitted by the Louisiana
18	Association of Nurse Anesthetists, Ltd., and two representatives of the consumers
19	of Louisiana from the state at-large appointed by the governor, neither of whom shall
20	be a nurse. Each board member shall possess all of the applicable qualifications
21	provided in R.S. 37:916.

26	governor, who may consider a list, containing twice the number of eligibles to be

29	Practical Nurses, Inc., for one of the practical nurses, by the Licensed Practical

9	A. There is hereby created in the Louisiana Department of Health the
10	Louisiana Licensed Professional Counselors Board of Examiners, hereafter referred
11	to as the "board", consisting of eleven members who shall be residents of the state
12	of Louisiana. Each term shall be for four years. Seven appointments to the board,
13	including one consumer from the public at large, shall be made by the governor from
14	who may consider a list of qualified candidates submitted by the executive board of
15	the Louisiana Counseling Association. The consumer member may also apply
16	directly to the office of the governor. Four appointments to the board shall be made
17	by the governor from who may consider a list of qualified candidates submitted by
18	the executive board of the Louisiana Association for Marriage and Family Therapy.
19	Each appointment by the governor shall be submitted to the Senate for confirmation.

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1	C. No board member shall serve more than two full consecutive terms. Any
2	board member may be removed by the governor or majority vote of the board, after
3	notice and hearing, for incompetence, neglect of duty, malfeasance in office, or
4	moral turpitude. Any vacancy occurring in board membership for the three licensed
5	professional counselors, three counselor educators, or one member of the public at
6	large, other than by expiration of term, shall be appointed for the remainder of the
7	unexpired term by the governor within thirty days from who may consider a list of
8	qualified candidates supplied by the executive board of the Louisiana Counseling
9	Association. Any vacancy occurring in board membership for the four licensed
10	marriage and family therapists, other than by expiration of term, shall be appointed
11	for the remainder of the unexpired term by the governor within thirty days from who

18	B. The board shall consist of ten voting members, all appointed by the
19	governor and subject to Senate confirmation as follows:
20	(1) Two members who may be selected from a list of names submitted by
21	the Louisiana State Medical Society. One of the members so appointed shall practice
22	in a parish or municipality with a population of less than twenty thousand people.
23	(2) One member who may be selected from a list of names submitted by the
24	Louisiana State University Health Sciences Center at New Orleans. At least every
25	other member appointed who may be considered from a list provided for in this
26	Paragraph shall be a minority appointee. Nothing in this Paragraph shall preclude
27	consecutive minority appointments from lists provided for in this Paragraph.
28	(3) One member who may be selected from a list of names submitted by the
29	Louisiana State University Health Sciences Center at Shreveport. At least every

1	other member appointed who may be considered from a list provided for in this
2	Paragraph shall be a minority appointee. Nothing in this Paragraph shall preclude
3	consecutive minority appointments from lists provided for in this Paragraph.

5	Tulane Medical School.

25	a population of less than twenty thousand people.

6	B.(1) The committee shall be composed of a total of seven persons,
7	including four persons who hold an active license to engage in the practice of
8	perfusion in this state and are appointed by the governor from who may consider a
9	list of names submitted by the Louisiana Perfusion Society, or from the general
10	perfusion community should the Louisiana Perfusion Society disband; two
11	physicians who are actively engaged in the practice of cardiothoracic surgery,
12	appointed by the governor from who may consider a list of names submitted by the
13	Louisiana Society of Thoracic Surgeons; and one representative from a hospital with
14	an active open heart program, appointed by the governor from who may consider a
15	list of names submitted by the Louisiana Hospital Association. The initial

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1	B. The State Plumbing Board is created. The board, which shall be
2	appointed by the governor, shall consist of one registered mechanical engineer who
3	is also licensed by the State Plumbing Board, one plumbing inspector who is also
4	licensed by the State Plumbing Board, three master plumbers, three journeyman
5	plumbers, one residential plumber limited, and two members of the public. Each
6	appointment shall be made in the following manner:

21	district and one at-large member appointed by the governor from who may consider
22	a list of names submitted by the board of directors of the Louisiana Chapter of the
23	American Society of Home Inspectors, the Louisiana Realtors Association, and the
24	Louisiana Home Builders Association. Each member of the board shall be a United
25	States citizen and a resident of the state, and shall have been actively engaged in the
26	home inspection business on a full-time basis for three years preceding the
27	appointment. The initial board members shall be required to obtain a license in

1	accordance with the provisions of this Chapter. Thereafter, each member of the board
2	shall be a licensed home inspector.

23	shall be appointed from by the governor, who may consider a list of three names
24	submitted by the Louisiana Asphalt Pavement Association.

26	be hearing aid dealers, the eighth member shall be the state health officer or his		
27	representative, and the ninth member shall be fifty years of age or over and shall		
28	serve as a representative of the hearing aid consumers of Louisiana. The seven		
29	hearing aid dealers shall be appointed in the following manner. The Louisiana		

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Society of Hearing Aid Specialists, chartered by the state, shall submit to the
 governor names of not less than fourteen qualified hearing aid dealers, who shall be
 actively engaged in the selling and fitting of hearing aids. The governor may
 <u>consider this list when making appointments and shall ensure that his appointments</u>
 demonstrate race, gender, ethnic, and geographical diversity.

Of the seven hearing aid dealer members of the board, one shall be 10 appointed to serve a term of four years, two shall be appointed to serve for a term of 11 three years, two shall be appointed to serve for a term of two years, and two shall be 12 appointed to serve for a term of one year. Each member so appointed shall serve for 13 the term of his appointment, and thereafter until his successor has been appointed by 14 the governor. Each member shall be appointed for a term of four years. In the event 15 of a vacancy on the board, the governor shall appoint a new hearing aid dealer board 16 member to serve out the unexpired term. The members of the board shall annually 17 designate one such member to serve as chairman and another member to serve as 18 secretary-treasurer.
