INSURANCE COMMISSIONER: Provides for confidential information relative to public inspection

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 22:1464(D), relative to rate filing; to provide for public
3 inspection with respect to rates and supporting information; to provide for the duties
4 and responsibilities of the commissioner of insurance; to require the commissioner
5 of insurance to determine if information is confidential, trade secret, or proprietary
6 relative to public inspection; and to provide for related matters.

7 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

8 Section 1. R.S. 22:1464(D) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

9 §1464. Rate filing

10 * * *

11 D. All rates, supplementary rate information, and any supporting information
12 filed pursuant to this Subpart shall be open to public inspection upon expiration of
13 the notification period as applicable pursuant to R.S. 22:1451, or upon disapproval,
14 except for information ~~which is deemed~~ the commissioner determines is confidential,
15 trade secret, or proprietary ~~by the insurer or filer.~~

Abstract: Provides for the commissioner of insurance's determination of confidential, trade secret, or proprietary information relative to public inspection.

Present law provides for public inspection of all rates, supplementary rate information, and any supporting information upon expiration of the notification periods provided for in present law (R.S. 22:1451), or upon rate disapproval by the commissioner of insurance (commissioner), except for information deemed confidential, trade secret, or proprietary by the insurer or filer.

Proposed law modifies present law to require the commissioner to determine whether information is confidential, trade secret, or proprietary. Deletes relative to confidential, trade secret, or proprietary information deemed so by an insurer or filer. Otherwise retains present law.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on Insurance to the original bill:

1. Make a technical change to the title to include duties and responsibilities of the commissioner of insurance.
