- 6 generation facility constructed prior to September 1, 2024, to come into compliance with this
- 7 Section to the extent practicable."

8 AMENDMENT NO. 3

- 9 On page 11, line 15, after "vegetation, shall" delete the remainder of the line and at the
- beginning of line 16, delete "evergreen trees to ensure a" and insert "ensure an opaque"

11 AMENDMENT NO. 4

- On page 11, at the end of line 17, insert "Existing vegetation on-site may be retained
- undisturbed in satisfaction of the vegetative barrier requirement if it otherwise meets the
- 14 applicable depth requirement and creates a continuous, opaque visual barrier."

15 AMENDMENT NO. 5

- On page 12, line 25, after "water bodies," delete the remainder of the line and delete lines
- 17 26 and 27 in their entirety and insert "a one hundred foot deep vegetative barrier is required."
