Abstract: Requires instruction in financial literacy to include financial aid for postsecondary education.

<u>Present law</u> requires high school students to complete a one unit Financial Literacy course to be eligible to graduate from a public high school, receive a diploma, and qualify for certain financial aid.

<u>Present law</u> specifies minimum content components of the course. <u>Proposed law</u> requires financial aid for postsecondary education as a component.
