Current law provides for the licensure and regulation of explosives. Current law requires that costs incurred by the Department of Public Safety (DPS) for processing State Police and FBI fingerprint cards be borne by the applicant. Proposed legislation requires that costs incurred by the DPS for conducting a background investigation and criminal history records check to be borne by the applicant.

The Louisiana State Police partners with IdentoGO, a third-party service, to conduct fingerprint-based background checks. Applicants are responsible for paying the associated fees directly to IdentoGO.
