The ballot shall be mailed by the board secretary at least ninety days prior to any vacancy occurring by reason of an expiring term or within thirty days after a vacancy occurring by reason of death, resignation, or for any other reason. After the board secretary has tabulated all ballots received at the board offices, the names of the three nominees receiving the greatest number of votes shall be certified by the secretary and sent to the governor.

§1104. Louisiana Licensed Professional Counselors Board of Examiners

A. There is hereby created in the Louisiana Department of Health the Louisiana Licensed Professional Counselors Board of Examiners, hereafter referred to as the "board", consisting of eleven members who shall be residents of the state of Louisiana. Each term shall be for four years. Seven appointments to the board, including one consumer from the public at large, shall be made by the governor from who may consider a list of qualified candidates submitted by the executive board of the Louisiana Counseling Association. The consumer member may also apply directly to the office of the governor. Four appointments to the board shall be made by the governor from who may consider a list of qualified candidates submitted by the executive board of the Louisiana Association for Marriage and Family Therapy. Each appointment by the governor shall be submitted to the Senate for confirmation. The governor shall ensure that his appointments demonstrate race, gender, ethnic, and geographical diversity.

Of the seven hearing aid dealer members of the board, one shall be appointed to serve a term of four years, two shall be appointed to serve for a term of three years, two shall be appointed to serve for a term of two years, and two shall be appointed to serve for a term of one year. Each member so appointed shall serve for the term of his appointment, and thereafter until his successor has been appointed by the governor. Each member shall be appointed for a term of four years. In the event of a vacancy on the board, the governor shall appoint a new hearing aid dealer board member to serve out the unexpired term.
