1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

- 2 On page 1, line 5, after "term limits;" insert "to provide for restrictions for board members
- 3 and employees;"
- 4 AMENDMENT NO. 2
- 5 On page 2, delete lines 15 through 20, and insert the following:
- 6 "always at least two four professionals with at least ten years of experience in their
- 7 respective professional disciplines on the board, one of whom shall be an a civil engineer
- 8 who shall reside on the Westbank of Jefferson Parish."
- 9 AMENDMENT NO. 3
- On page 3, between lines 4 and 5, insert the following:
- 11 "(c) No member of the board, or any of the immediate family of the 12 member, shall own or have any interest or part in any business, company, or entity conducting business of any kind with the authority or levee district within 13 14 the territorial jurisdiction of the authority or any of the facilities controlled by the authority or any such district. "Immediate family" as used in this 15 Subparagraph means his children, the spouses of his children, his brothers and 16 17 their spouses, his sisters and their spouses, his parents, his spouse, the parents of his spouse, his spouse's brothers and their spouses, his spouse's sisters and 18 19 their spouses, and his spouse's children.
- 20 (d) No former board member may qualify as a candidate for any elected office within twelve months of the termination of his term on the board.
- 22 (e) No elected official or former elected official may serve as a member 23 of the board within twenty-four months of the termination of his term.
- 24 (f) No public employee or former public employee shall serve as a
 25 member of the board within twelve months of the termination of his
 26 employment other than as a member of the board.
- 27 (g) No member shall accept or receive political campaign contributions 28 or in-kind political donations from any source."
