SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 76

BY SENATOR DUPLESSIS

CHILDREN. Requests the Department of Children and Family Services to provide information regarding luggage provided to foster children.

1	A RESOLUTION
2	To request the Department of Children and Family Services to provide information
3	regarding luggage provided to children who are removed from their homes or
4	changing foster care placement.
5	WHEREAS, children who are removed from their home on an emergency basis are
6	not given much time to pack their belongings and are often times given a trash bag to carry
7	their items; and
8	WHEREAS, when children are given trash bags to transport their belongings, it sends
9	the message that the children and their belongings are trash and have no value; and
10	WHEREAS, the children of Louisiana deserve to be treated with dignity and be given
11	hope in these horrible situations; and
12	WHEREAS, in Louisiana, the Department of Children and Family Services' policy
13	provides that foster parents can be reimbursed up to one hundred dollars for a one-time
14	luggage expense or as approved by a foster care worker; and
15	WHEREAS, there is no requirement for children to be given luggage at the point they
16	are being removed from their homes or when they are changing foster care placement; and
17	WHEREAS, Maryland, Texas, and Oregon have passed laws in recent years to
18	prohibit the use of trash bags to transport the belongings of children being removed from

their home or changing foster care placement; and

WHEREAS, these laws require the state's respective department of human services to establish and maintain a decentralized supply of luggage to be used to transport a foster child's personal belongings, develop procedures for the storage and distribution of luggage to ensure the maximum number of children are able to use the luggage, and require the department to provide luggage to children who are being removed from their home or changing placement; and

WHEREAS, providing a child with luggage instead of a trash bag when they are being taken from their home could improve that child's self-worth and hope for the future.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate of the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby request the Department of Children and Family Services to submit a report to the legislature that includes the following information:

- (1) The department's current process for providing luggage to children who are removed from their home or changing foster care placement.
- (2) The number of children who were removed from their home or changed placement in the previous year.
- (3) The number of children who were provided luggage by the department at the point they were removed from their home or when they changed placement in the previous year.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Children and Family Services shall submit the report to the Senate Committee on Health and Welfare no later than January 1, 2026.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the secretary of the Department of Children and Family Services.
