SPECIAL DISTRICTS. Provides for the French Quarter Management District. (8/1/25)

2	To amend and reenact R.S. 25:799(C)(1)(b), (c), (d), (e), (j), (k), and (l), and to enact R.S.
3	25:799(K)(4) relative to the French Quarter Management District; to provide relative
4	to the board of commissioners; to make technical changes; to provide relative to
5	sanitation services; and to provide for related matters.
6	Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 25:799(C)(1)(b), (c), (d), (e), (j), (k), and (l) are hereby amended and
9	reenacted and R.S. 25:799(K)(4) is hereby enacted to read as follows:
10	§799. Creation of the French Quarter Management District

12	C. Governance. (1) The district shall be governed by a board of
13	commissioners consisting of thirteen members as follows:

15	(b) One person who is domiciled and a qualified elector in the district,
16	appointed by the Vieux Carre Property Owners, Residents and Associates, Inc

23	(4) When the city of New Orleans, due to a lack of city-employed staff or
24	a lawfully contracted vendor, cannot provide sanitation services within the
25	French Quarter, the district may procure its own emergency contract to ensure

27	sanitation services procured pursuant to this Section shall be reimbursed by the
28	city of New Orleans. The emergency contract procured by the district shall
29	continue until such time as the city resumes service through its own employees

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 25:799) provides for the creation of the French Quarter Management District.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and provides that when the city of New Orleans, due to a lack of city-employed staff or a lawfully contracted vendor, cannot provide sanitation services within the French Quarter, the district may procure its own emergency contract to ensure continuation of services within its boundaries.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the costs for emergency sanitation services procured pursuant to <u>proposed law</u> shall be reimbursed by the city of New Orleans.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the emergency contract procured by the district shall continue until such time as the city resumes service through its own employees or pursuant to a lawfully procured and executed contract.

Effective August 1, 2025.

(Amends R.S. 25:799(C)(1)(b), (c), (d), (e), (j), (k), and (l); adds R.S. 25:799(K)(4))
