Abstract: Authorizes certain commissioned officers employed by the Dept. of Agriculture and Forestry to purchase their service firearms at fair market value upon retirement.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that any member of the State Employees' Retirement System who is a commissioned officer employed by the Dept. of Agriculture and Forestry pursuant to <u>present law</u> (R.S. 3:734 or 4274.1), who has at least 20 years of active service, and who retires under the provisions of <u>present law</u> (R.S. 11:441) be entitled to purchase his service firearm at fair market value, subject to the approval of the commissioner of agriculture and forestry.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
