AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, line 11, after "59-B." and before "GENOMIC SECURITY", insert "HUMAN"

"(4) "Foreign adversary company" means any company, other than a United States person or United States subsidiary as defined in 15 CFR 772.1, that is any of the following:

(a) Domiciled, incorporated, issued, or listed in a foreign adversary country,

(b) Headquartered in a foreign adversary country,

(c) Has its principal place of business in a foreign adversary country.

(d) Controlled by the government of the People's Republic of China, the Chinese Communist Party, the Chinese military, or any instrumentality thereof, including the State-owned Assets Supervision and Administration Commission of the State Council or the National Social Security Fund.

(e) Is majority-owned by an entity controlled by the government of the People's Republic of China, the Chinese Communist Party, the Chinese military, or any instrumentality thereof, including the State-owned Assets Supervision and Administration Commission of the State Council or the National Social Security Fund.

(f) Itself receives or is the subsidiary of a parent company which receives more than fifty percent of its total annual revenue from a foreign adversary country."

5 "§3185. Penalties; powers of the attorney general

6 A.(1) A medical facility or human genomic research facility that violates the  
7 provisions of this Chapter shall be fined ten thousand dollars per violation. A  
8 violation means each unique instance of an individual's genome having undergone  
9 genetic sequencing or analysis using a prohibited human genetic sequencer or a  
10 prohibited operational or research software.

11 (2) A medical facility, human genomic research facility, or company that  
12 knowingly violates the provisions of this Chapter by storing human genetic  
13 sequencing data in a foreign adversary country shall be fined ten thousand dollars per  
14 violation.

15 B. The attorney general has the sole authority to investigate allegations of  
16 violations of this Chapter and to enforce violations of R.S. 51:3183 and 3184.

17 Section 2. The provisions of R.S. 51:3183(A) as enacted by Section 1 of this Act  
18 shall have prospective application only upon signature of the governor."
