<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 33:1221) provides that police jurors shall serve four year terms.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> but provides that no person who has been elected to serve as a police juror in Sabine Parish for more than two and one-half terms shall be eligible to serve as a police juror for any term thereafter.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the limit on the number of terms a member of the police jury in Sabine Parish may serve shall be subject to approval of a majority of the electors voting at an election held on November 3, 2026.

Effective August 1, 2025.
